Within the next 12 months, the OFE allows for the possibility of increasing the number of shares depending on the development of the market situation and the Company. The purpose of the acquisition of shares of the Company is to invest the assets in a OFE's investment activity in order to achieve a maximum degree of safety and profitability of investments. OFE does not exclude the sale of shares in the event of a corresponding increase in its value, or changes in the evolution of the market situation and the Company's operations.
